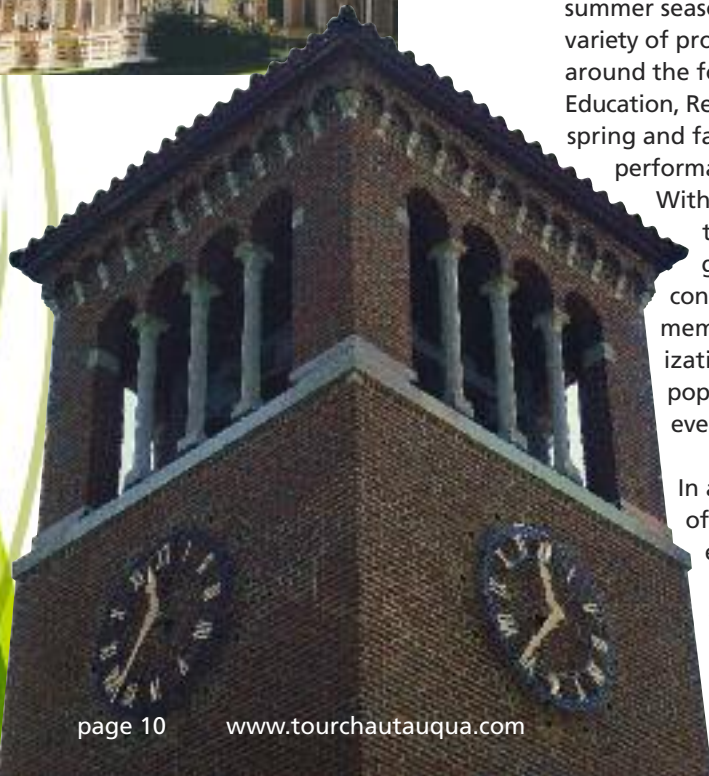
In addition, an array of recreational possibilities offer attendees opportunities to unwind and will enhance an already productive conference.
