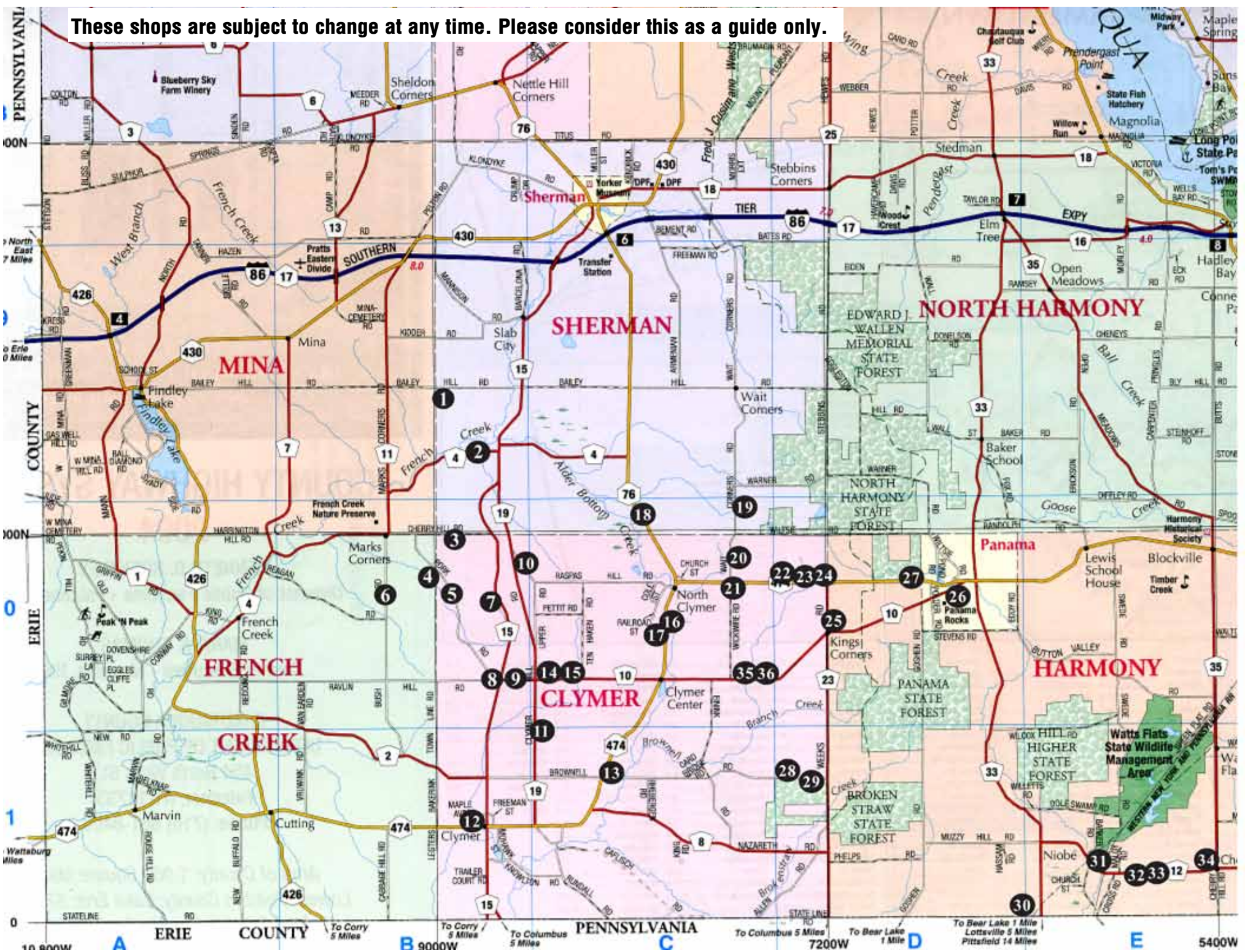

1. No photos of Amish
2. No Sunday sales
3. Tour Bus by permission only

New York State Sales Tax is collected on taxable goods unless you have a tax number and your are able to provide a Resale Certificate.

In addition, please understand that some operational aspects of the Amish businesses carry inherent dangers that require you to exercise caution. The Amish do not accept responsibility for any accidents while you are on their property.

It is important to realize that Amish shops, some of which are located in their homes, have flexible business hours. (Eastern Standard Time is followed all year round) You will also find that inventory levels will fluctuate according to seasonal demands (i.e.: planting & harvesting) Therefore, please be understanding of the variables while on your trip to the Amish Shops.

We hope you will enjoy your visit to Amish Country. We know you will appreciate the quality of the Amish made goods that you will discover.
