

FOR THE BIRDS

JAMESTOWN, NY ESTIMATED TOUR TIME – 6 HOURS

CHAUTAUQUA REGION OF WESTERN NEW YORK

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The Lucy-Desi Museum and Desilu Playhouse will be the first stop on a “For the Birds” tour. Located in downtown Jamestown, NY, the Lucy-Desi Center is a tribute to Lucille Ball, the world’s most beloved comedian. The museum will delight you with exhibits and many personal belongings on display. The Desilu Playhouse offers exact replicas of the “*I Love Lucy*” television studio sets. Finish this stop with some shopping in the gift shop and browsing through the largest selection of all things Lucy.



“Lucy Raises Chickens”, an episode of “*I Love Lucy*” will be featured during lunch in the famous Tropicana Room. Laugh while you dine.



Next stop is the Roger Tory Peterson Institute, home of the lifetime body of works of the foremost naturalist of the twentieth century. The building, designed by Robert A.M. Stern, is set on a 22-acre wooded setting with hiking trails. Browse the natural history library and shop the nature store. Enjoy nature art and photography.

Turn your day tour into an overnight stay and check into the Comfort Inn. Bob Evans Restaurant is located on the property for dinner on own.



Optional Day Two: Travel to the Audubon Center and Sanctuary south of Jamestown and see hands on exhibits in the Nature Center, live animals, and Liberty, a resident, non-releasable Bald Eagle. Visit the nature store or walk along some of the 5 miles of hiking/skiing trails. View 600 acres of forest with field and pond habitat. Browse an arboretum with over 60 native tree species as well as butterfly, herb, and native plant gardens.
